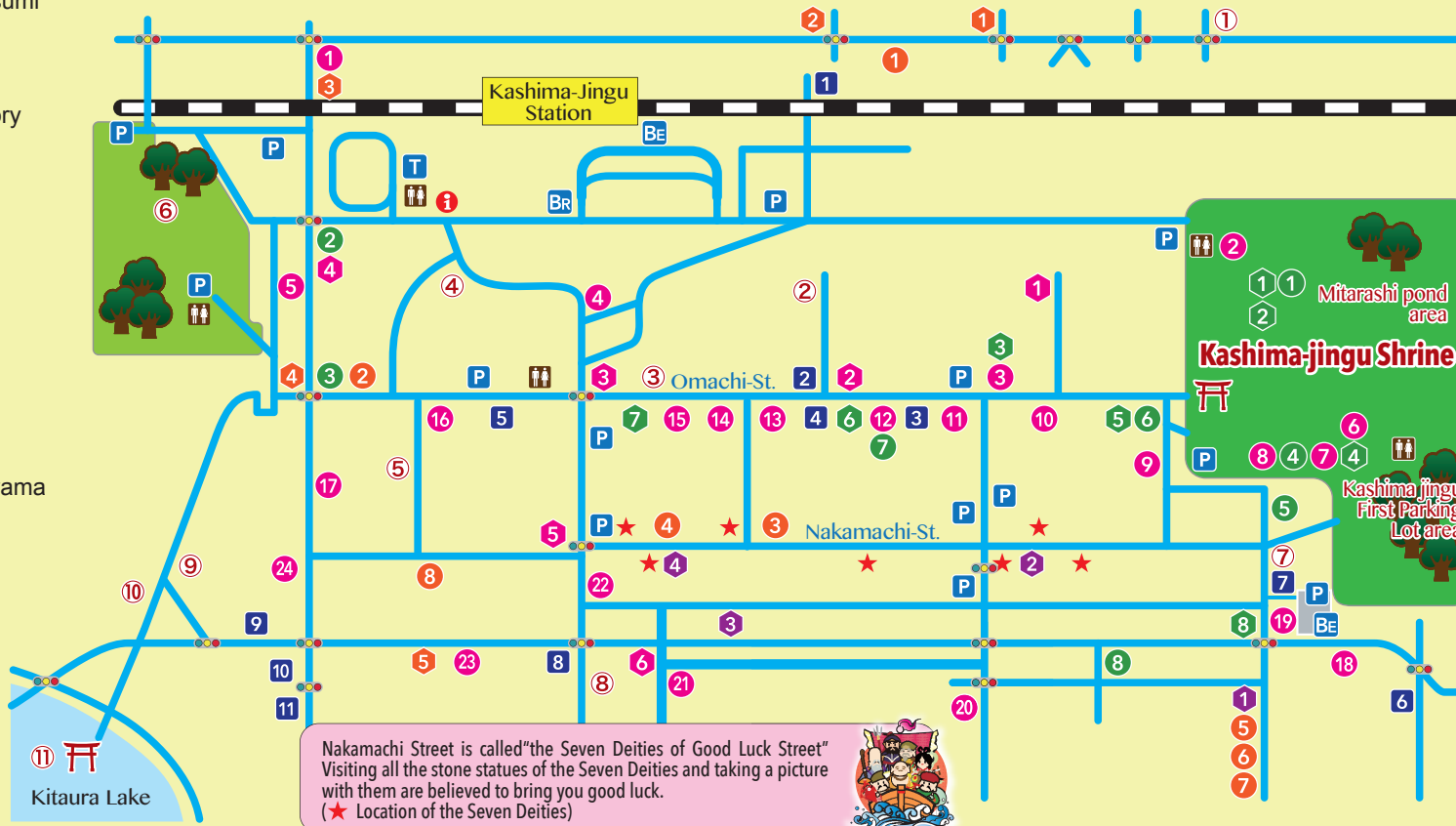

Nakamachi Street is called "the Seven Deities of Good Luck Street". Visiting all the stone statues of the Seven Deities and taking a picture with them are believed to bring you good luck. (★ Location of the Seven Deities)



1 Kashima Soccer Stadium

It is the home stadium of the Kashima Antlers of the Japanese professional football league. When home games are played, the stands are filled with enthusiastic fans who wear red the home color.

2 Inari-jinja Shrine

It is enshrined to Ukemochi-no-kami to pray for a rich harvest.

3 Ryu-jinja Shrine

It is one of Hachiryu-jin of Kashima-jingu who prays for saving enough water and provides protection from fire.

4 The Statue of Bokuden Tsukahara

He was a great swordsman who was born in Kashima in the Warring States period. People said "He always won, he never lost in his life".

5 Gokoku-in Temple

It was erected in 709. It contains the 88 sacred places and one complete this pilgrimage.

6 Kashima Shiroyama Park

This land was used to built Kashima Castle. It is amazing when the cherry blossoms, Sakura are in bloom.

7 Ise-jinja Shrine

It is enshrined Amaterasu Omikami. It stands as a local deity of Nakamachi area.

8 Atago-jinja Shrine

It is known for enshrining deities that provide protection from fire. It became a branch shrine of Atago-jinja shrine of Edo(Tokyo).

9 Konpon Temple and short poem of Basho Matsuo

One of the oldest temple in Japan that was founded by Prince Shotoku. Inside is the poem monument of Basho Matsuo, a famous Japanese poet who visited this temple.

10 Kamatari-jinja Shrine

It is enshrined Nakatomi-no-Kamatari, was born in Kashima who played an important role in the Taika Reforms in 645.

11 The first Torii of Kashima-jingu Shrine

From the ancient times, Ofunatsu port flourished as an important point for water transportation, and the entrance to Kashima-jingu shrine. This Torii was rebuilt in June, 2013 to withstand all types of weather. It was made by the Nippon Steel & Sumitomo Metal Corporation. From the bottom of the river, it is 18.5 meters tall and 22.5 meters wide making it one of the biggest Torii on water in Japan.
